## Nation's First Wood Key Card to Debut in Hotels During the Democratic National Convention

More than 70,000 biodegradable key cards will be used in Denver hotels, reinforcing "green" convention theme and greatly reducing waste

The weight and density of this waste is equal to the volume of seven 777 airplanes.

"We've reached a point where consumers no longer want to frequent hotels and resorts that aren't embracing green business practices," said Greg Hartmann, President and CEO of Sustainable Cards. "Our mission is to reduce non-biodegradable card waste to zero

during the convention and throughout the year by encouraging the use of our eco-friendly wood cards in every hotel in America."

The Democratic National Convention 2008 will be held August 25-28, 2008 at the Pepsi Center. An anticipated 35,000 hotel guests will use wood Sustainable Cards for the first time in the U.S.
